JOB DESCRIPTION

1. Senior Consultant- MSME

Qualifications:

A master's degree in Economics/ Statistics from a renowned and recognized institution.

Desirable: - PhD degree in Economics from a recognized University can also apply for the Post.

- Shall have good knowledge in MS office tools (Excel, Power Point etc.) & statistical tools as necessary.

Scope of Work (Experience & Skills):

Mandatory :

Minimum post qualification work experience of 5 years in the Indian corporate sector or MSME sector as an Economist. The person needs to be conversant with MSME scenario.

The candidate is expected to have a :

- (i) Strong Knowledge in Economic and Policy Research with a focus on MSME sector
- (ii) role in policy formulation, analysis Economic and Policy Research with a focus on MSME sector.
- (iii) experience in data collation from various sources and undertake analytics.
- (iv) Assist Principal Researchers / Head, MSME in planning and executing research projects.
- (v) Perform various technical tasks like sample preparation, testing, data collection, analysis and reporting.
- (vi) Ensure proper operation, maintenance, and calibration of research equipment and instruments.
- (vii) Contribute to the development of research protocols and standard operating procedures.
- (viii) Collaborate with cross-functional teams to achieve research objectives.
- (ix) Maintain detailed records and documentation of research activities.

Desirable :

- a) Experience in designing / implementation of State level Projects in MSME sector / Program Management / Technical Assistance / Programme Development /State Program Implementation Unit / PMUs for various development programs / GOI schemes preferably with focus on MSMEs or startups with a strong track record.
- b) Experience in working for State Governments in hand holding and running Government of India / State Government programs / MSME cluster development projects or MSME Programs /establishing business and marketing linkages.
- c) Deep understanding of the overall MSME sector and MSME ecosystem as well as various products/schemes available for the MSMEs and challenges and needs of MSMEs.
- d) Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to interact effectively with entrepreneurs and stakeholders.

Job Responsibilities:

- i. Facilitate partnerships and collaborations that enhance IICA's initiatives and support the growth of SMEs.
- ii. Providing inputs on macroeconomic.
- iii. Providing inputs on strategy and policy based on macroeconomic developments.
- iv. Play a role in policy formulation, analysis and communication.
- v. Develop and maintain the master project plan for the MSME sector initiative, defining clear phases, milestones, dependencies, and timelines for each component.(e.g. Capacity Building Training Programs / Workshops / White Paper / Training Modules etc)
- vi. Serve as the primary liaison and build strong working relationships with senior officials at the Central Ministry and key MSME ecosystem partners.
- vii. Build and maintain relationships with key stakeholders including regulatory bodies, industry groups and other institutions and also represent IICA, whereby required.
- viii. The selected SRA shall work with the IICA on Strategy, provide market insights and help explore or create opportunities for the IICA.
- ix. Any other work assigned by the IICA from time to time.

Remuneration and other Conditions:

- Selected candidates shall be required to sign a contract with IICA and join the duties immediately.
- No other allowances will be payable. However if the person, travel out of the Headquarters he will be entitled to TA/DA as admissible.
- The assignment is on a full time basis and the person will be required to attend the office on all the working days and on holidays, if required.
- The period of engagement will be initially for a period of one year, which may, at the discretion of the competent authority be either extended or curtailed depending on performance and requirement.
- The Consultant shall not be permitted to apply for any position internally or outside IICA till his/her contract is valid or before 02 years of joining to the existing position (in case the contract has provision for extension after one year of initial engagement) whichever is later. In case consultant wishes to apply internally for another position, he/she will be required to terminate the present contract with IICA.
- The person will be required to maintain decorum, discipline as expected of a Central Government Officer.
- The contract can be terminated by either side by giving notice for a period of one month or one month's consolidated emoluments in lieu thereof.
- The contract can be terminated without notice by the competent authority, if at any time the conduct, performance, activities of the individual are found detrimental to the interests of the organization.
- Initial engagement period of the selected candidates may be curtailed or enhanced with the approval of the Competent Authority at the time of issuing the offer of engagement.
- The number of positions or remuneration as indicated at Table-1 hereinabove may be decreased or increased with the approval of the competent authority, subject to requirement.
- The Annual increment will be on renewal of every extension as per the Increment Policy of the Institute.
- Conditions may be relaxed by the competent authority in exceptional circumstances.
