This training program provides holistic insights into the theory, practice, and procedure of arbitration. The program has been curated to provide a distinctive learning experience to the participants while equipping them with the core knowledge, skills, and expertise that are required to excel as an arbitration professional. This program is one of its kind as participants will experience practitioner-centric learning from our global pool of experts. I welcome all the participants for the training program.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM

With increase in cross-border trade and commerce, commercial and contractual disputes have exponentially increased among the parties across the world. In order to ensure smooth work flow and avoid loss of time, business and money, parties require that these commercial disputes are resolved through a robust dispute resolution mechanism that ensures justice, cost-effectiveness and timely resolution of disputes. For resolution of these commercial disputes, arbitration has now become the most preferred option for the parties and hence, there is an exceptional increase in the number of disputes being referred to and resolved through arbitration. Consequentially, 'arbitration as a service' is emerging as one of the fastest growing sectors in the domain of alternate dispute resolution.

With advent of this new era in the domain of alternate dispute resolution, there is a dire need of trained and specialized professionals in order to cater to the needs of the commercial dispute resolution landscape in India. Therefore, while addressing such need and envisioning upcoming opportunities for professionals in the domain of commercial arbitration, the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India has come up with the '**IICA Certified Arbitration Program**' with the objective to create a highly efficient pool of trained arbitrators and specialized arbitration professionals towards making India the hub of commercial arbitration.

STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM

The program is designed to equip participants with in-depth understanding of various aspects of arbitration such as contractual and commercial disputes, arbitration practice and procedure, national and international legal frameworks among various others. The program is curated in a manner to skill, upskill and reskill the participants in accordance with their professional requirements so as to enable them to keep pace with the ever-growing complexities in the domain of commercial arbitration.

IICA Certified Arbitration Program (ICAP) is 250+ hours of comprehensive theoretical and practical training on arbitration. The twenty (20) course modules of the training program shall be taught in online mode and three (3) modules shall be taught in-person (with online option available) over two campus immersions at IICA. The final assessment along with the valedictory session shall be conducted at IICA campus over a weekend of two days i.e. Saturday and Sunday. The complete training program shall be completed in nine (9) months.

This program is designed to provide the basic skills and knowledge needed to become an arbitration professional. This program focuses on theoretical as well as practical aspects of arbitration through live sessions, instructor-led training, self-study material and arbitration simulations. After successfully passing the final assessment, the participant will be qualified as **'IICA Qualified Arbitration Professional'**.



ONLINE COURSE MODULES

The 20 online course modules shall be taught over nine (9) months with each LIVE online session of ninety (90) minutes.



CAMPUS IMMERSION

The three (3) in-person modules shall be taught over two (2) campus immersions of five (5) days' each.



VALIDICTORY SESSION AND NETWORKING DINNER

Certificate Distribution and Valedictory Session followed by a Networking Dinner shall be held at IICA Campus.



IICA QUALIFIED ARBITRATION PROFESSIONAL

Participants receiving Certificate of Completion will be qualified as 'IICA Qualified Arbitration Professional'.

FINAL ASSESSMENT

To be eligible for appearing in the Final Assessment, a participant requires a minimum of 80% attendance in aggregate of all the sessions. The participants have to successfully pass the Final Assessment in order to receive the Certificate of Completion and be qualified as **"IICA Qualified Arbitration Professional"**. The Final Assessment shall consist of one graded component namely; Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs).

CERTIFICATION

The certification provided under this IICA Certified Arbitration Program (ICAP) shall be **"IICA Qualified Arbitration Professional"**. Participants who successfully qualify as **"IICA Qualified Arbitration Professional"** shall become eligible to appear for the Arbitrator Qualifying Assessment Program (AQAP) under the fast-track route for upgraded certification of **"IICA Certified Arbitrator"**.
