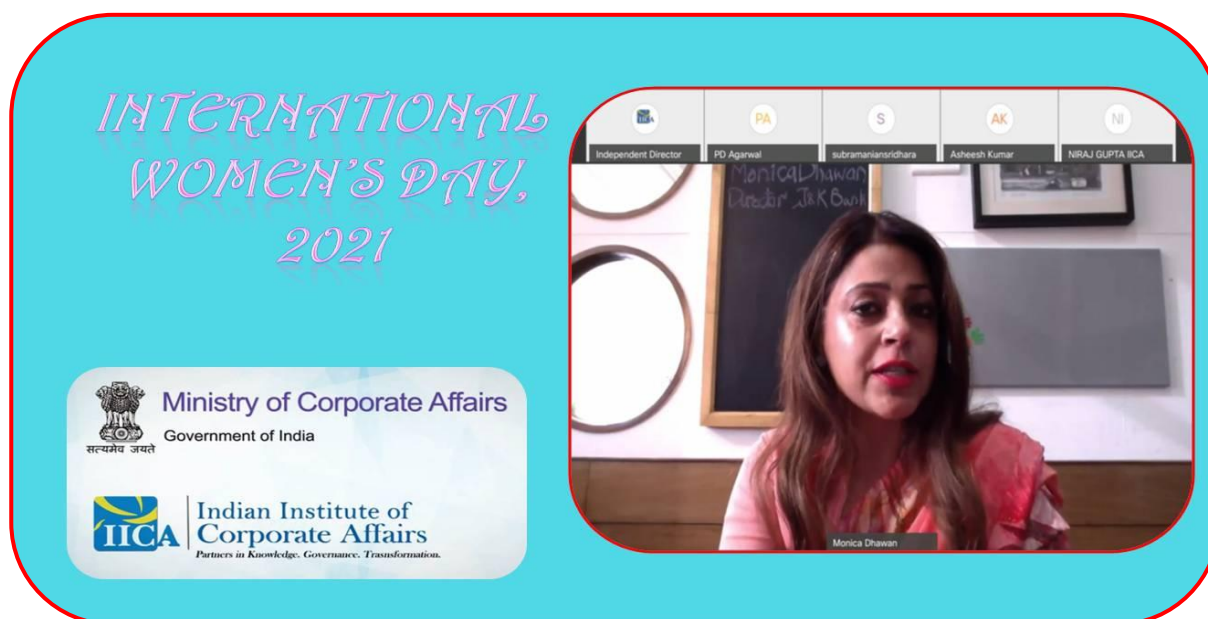


Power Talk with Ms. Monica Dhawan
