

## **Power Panel: CORPORATE GOVERNANCE – LOOK THROUGH LISTING REGULATIONS**



Centre for Independent Directors, IICA organized **Power Panel: CORPORATE GOVERNANCE – LOOK THROUGH LISTING REGULATIONS** program for the respected members of Independent Director's Databank on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2021.

The main objective of the program was to spread some light on Corporate Governance norms arising from Listing Regulations. Listing Regulations formalized by SEBI and recognized stock exchanges, have important role in emergence of Indian stock markets as fair play ground for Investors in India and around the world. To ensure the integrity of functionality of stock markets and interest of investors, Listing Regulations ask for compliance of various stated obligations by listed entities.

The Program commenced on 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 at 04:30 PM with the theme address of Dr. Niraj Gupta, Head, School of Corporate Governance and Public Policy & Nodal Officer, Centre for Independent Director, IICA. Panellists also discussed procedures for disclosure of information in effective manner.
