The Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) successfully concluded a two-day 'Orientation programme for Government Nominee Directors' in Puducherry on 17-18 January 2019. Organized in association with the Department of Public Enterprises, the programme witnessed engaged participation by 14 senior officials representing over 13 ministries under Govt. of India.

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## **RESEARCH & PRACTICE**

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### **IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF CSR PROJECTS BY 100 MINING COMPANIES**

*National Foundation for Corporate Social Responsibility (NFCSR)*

NFCSR is conducting nation-wide research to assess the impact of the CSR projects by companies - particularly in the mining sector - in tribal and backward regions of the country. The study aims to conduct a detailed study on the CSR expenditure and implementation of CSR projects in different development sectors by a sample of 100 companies. A sample size of 5512 households in 82

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villages has been calculated by the NFCSR team across all the zones in the country. NFCSR has officially empanelled an external agency to collect the data from all the 82 villages. The data collection tools were provided by NFCSR which were translated in 5 vernacular languages and installed in CAPI by the agency under the supervision of NFCSR team. The data collection process has started across the zones.

## **IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF CSR PROJECTS BY NUMALIGARH REFINERY LIMITED**

*National Foundation for Corporate Social Responsibility (NFCSR)*

NFCSR is in the process of conducting impact assessment study for the CSR projects initiated by NRL during the period 2015-2018 in Golaghat District in Jorhat region, Assam. NFCSR hired 10 experienced field researchers from Assam for the purpose of data collection. In order to gain an in-depth understanding of the various CSR projects spread across 102 villages of

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Golaghat, specially structured questionnaires were prepared for the projects – grid electrification, solar street and home light, drinking water supply, school infrastructure, household toilet construction, mobile medicare camps, skill development and livelihood initiatives, which were pilot tested in 3 villages during the visit of NFCSR team. The data collection tools were modified after the pilot study on the basis of the responses received.

## **REAL-TIME MONITORING OF CSR PROJECTS OF AGRICULTURE INSURANCE COMPANY OF INDIA LIMITED**

*National Foundation for Corporate Social Responsibility (NFCSR)*

IICA entered into a MoU with Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited (AICL) for monitoring their CSR projects for the Integrated Village Development Program (IVDP). The first phase of IVDP has been successfully completed with the construction of 3670 household toilets, installation of 1230 solar street lights and 122 solar water pumps in 50 villages. AICL now intends to extend the IVDP and install 650 solar street lights and 30 solar water pumps in Motihari, East Champaran area of Bihar. AICL has also hired an implementing agency for installation of the solar street light and water pumps. The NFCSR team at IICA

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is performing the role of real-time monitoring and evaluation during the installation of the equipment for the on-going implementation of CSR projects.

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## **IMPACT ASSESSMENT STUDIES FOR MAHANADI COALFIELDS LIMITED**

*National Foundation for Corporate Social Responsibility (NFCSR)*

NFCSR prepared a project proposal for the impact assessment study for Mahanadi Coalfields Limited. The broad objectives of the study were relevance, efficiency, impact and sustainability of the projects in the respective thematic areas – rural development, health and sanitation, education and promotion of cultural heritage. The technical, as well as financial project proposal by IICA which comprised of impact assessment procedure, research methodology for MCL, was approved by MCL and is now commencing on February 2019.

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## **INSTITUTION**

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### **IICA ESTABLISHES THE INTEGRATED ADVOCACY FULCRUM TO STRENGTHEN ADVOCACY EFFORTS**

To keep the Indian legal framework in tune with this rapidly changing environment, several laws have been enacted or amended in the last decade. It is expected that this constant change in the regulatory environment will be conducive to the economic growth of the country. In this context, stakeholder advocacy is being increasingly viewed as IICA's highest strategic priority. The Integrated Advocacy Fulcrum (IAF) at IICA was established in January 2019 with the objective of engaging stakeholders in the government, academia and civil society. Mr. Santhosh Parashar, Former Head of Corporate Affairs & Capital Markets, PEVCAI, ASSOCHAM has been appointed as the Chief Programme Executive to drive the activities of this newly formed unit.
