The Centre for MSME has successfully conducted **Four-Day Residential Training Programme on “Procurement (Procedures, Tenders, Bids), EPC (Engineering, Procurement and Construction) & Contract Management” from 05th March to 08th March, 2019 at Goa**. The programme was designed to provide intensive training to the purchasing & supply managers, procurement managers, project managers, commercial managers, contract managers, Finance Officers and supply controllers of the Central Public Sector undertakings to provide insights on major issues like intricacies in Public Procurement, Enhancing efficiency of Public and Private sector through effective supply chain management, evolving trends in public procurement, e-procurement, policy and regulatory issues and many other related critical issues of today and the future.

The program brought together 30 senior procurement, project and finance professionals involved in public procurement from different Government Departments and PSUs to share the best practices and to discuss the critical issues of today & the future.

A total of seventeen sessions covered the pertinent areas under Effective Procurement & Contract Management such as Existing Public Procurement Guidelines – Challenges & Areas of concern, Present Regularly Framework for Public Procurement, Basics of Contracting, Drafting commercial Contracts, Procurement Process, Bid documentation and Bid invitation (NIT), Contract Negotiations, Contract administration & management, EPC (Engineering, Procurement and Construction) Contract, E-Contract, Bid Evaluation & Contract award, International Contract and dispute resolution mechanism, Contract termination/renewal decision, Effective Strategic Sourcing, Case study on valid contract/LOI/MOU.
