

**Three Day customized Training Program on
“Governance Regulatory and Compliance (GRC) Management for SMEs”
24th – 26th November, 2019 at Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh**

The Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs through its Centre for MSME has successfully conducted Three-day Capacity Building Training Programme on “Governance, Regulatory & Compliance Management for SMEs” from 24th - 26th November, 2019 for the officers of Directorate of Industries, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh at Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh. The programme was designed to provide intensive training to the nodal officers of the support agencies for the MSMEs i.e. Industry Department, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, to provide insights from the ground level and equip the state agencies and their nodal officers to further educate and support MSMEs teams in-house to identify applicable statutes that they have to abide as per the nature of their business and sensitize them about the compliances relating to licenses, approvals, returns records / registers, statutory dues and other compliances, who directly deals with or interested in Governance, Risk and Compliance functions of their respective organizations.

A total of eighteen sessions covered the pertinent areas under Governance, Regulatory & Compliance Management for SMEs and Present GST Regime such as Provisions of Companies Act, 2013, Export Import Documentation and SEZ, Project Preparation skills and assessing viability of Projects, E-Governance and its implications for SEZ, Mergers and Acquisitions, Financing of MSME, Economical and Financial Compliances, Environmental Laws, National Goods and Services Tax (GST) & Understanding Key Concepts of GST, Exit of Business, Project Appraisal and Data Analysis, Introduction to the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC), SMEs & Start-ups Eco-System, Corporate Social Responsibility, Work Ethics, Evaluation of useful Government Schemes for MSMEs, Promotion and development of Rural Clusters.

In this programme, in-house faculty as well as outsource faculty were engaged. The faculty for the programme was Mr. Rajesh Batra, Head, Centre for MSME, IICA and Mr. Rajeev Bhargava, Independent Practitioner.
