The **Centre for MSME, IICA** has successfully conducted organisation specific (**J&K Bank**) customised **Capacity Building Programme on “Procurement (Bidding Procedures based on GFR, GeM & E-Procurement) and Contract Management: Challenges in Implementation” on 3-6 February, 2020 at Srinagar exclusively for the officers of J&K Bank.** The programme was designed to provide intensive training to the purchasing & supply managers, procurement managers, project managers, commercial managers, contract managers, Finance Officers and supply controllers to provide insights on major issues like intricacies in Public Procurement, Enhancing efficiency of Public and Private sector through effective supply chain management, evolving trends in public procurement, e-procurement, Government guidelines & policies, regulatory issues and its practical aspects as well.

The program brought together 32 senior procurement, project, finance & legal professionals involved in public procurement from J&K Bank to share the best practices and to discuss the critical issues of today & the future.

A total of eighteen (18) sessions covered the pertinent areas such as Basics of Contracting, EPC (Engineering, Procurement and Construction) Contract, Drafting of Commercial Contracts, E-Contract, Contract administration & management, Dispute resolution mechanism and Resolution of Disputes- Arbitration proceedings, Futuristic Opportunities for SMEs & Corporate houses in Public Procurement through Offset policy and multiplier provisions, Overview of Public Procurement for enhancing transparency, efficiency & accountability in procurement process, Present Regulatory Framework for Public Procurement, Existing Public Procurement Guidelines – Challenges & Areas of concern, Bid documentation and Bid invitation (NIT), Bid Evaluation & Contract award, Procurement Process, Contract Negotiations, Contract termination/renewal decision, E-auction, Effective Strategic Sourcing, Make in India & Public Procurement.
