

Requirement of experienced Architects for the need assessment study:

For the purpose of conducting the need assessment study for the restoration of cultural heritage site, IICA requires a team of experts from architect background.

Requirement and Eligibility criteria:

1 Land surveyor (experienced in land surveying) and 3 architect graduates (B. Arch) will be hired for the position of field researcher for the purpose of land survey, infrastructure site survey and desk research for a period up to **10** days depending on the requirement of the study. The researchers will be provided a Project Stipend of **Rs. 2500** per day, per researcher (inclusive of accommodation, travel and other cost).

2 senior architect consultants will be hired for the position of research coordinator and supervisor for a period of up to **15 days**. The consultant must have a degree in **M. Arch** in Architectural Conservation and must be experienced in conducting assessment studies of heritage site. The consultants will be provided a Project stipend of **Rs. 4500** per day (inclusive of accommodation, travel and other cost).

Objective and Methodology of the Study

The consultant will be responsible for submitting the drawings and draft report of the assessment study of the heritage site.
