# Three Day Capacity Building Program on "Government e-Market Place (GeM) and General Financial Rules (GFR)"

(16 - 18 December, 2025 at IICA Campus, Manesar)

In the backdrop of India's growing market, manufacturing potential and target of becoming a developed country by 2047, **Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs** through its **Centre for MSME** has organised Three Day Capacity Building Program on "Government e-Marketplace (GeM) and General Financial Rules (GFR)" for the officials of Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) during 16-18 December, 2025 at IICA Campus, IMT Manesar, Distt. Gurugram.

The program outline covered the essential aspects of operating and handling the GeM web portal for both buyers and sellers as well as service providers, for driving Efficiency, Transparency and Inclusivity in India's public procurement domain. - Keynote Address by Sh. Gyaneshwar Kumar Singh, Director General & CEO, IICA
   In his Keynote Address, the DG & CEO, IICA highlighted the transformational role of the
   Government e-Marketplace (GeM) in strengthening transparency and accountability in
   public procurement. He underscored that GeM has introduced unprecedented levels of
   transparency by enabling:
  - ✓ Real-time price discovery through competitive bidding mechanisms
  - ✓ End-to-end digital audit trails for procurement decisions
  - ✓ Significant reduction in discretion and human interface in purchasing processes

The DG & CEO further elaborated, with practical examples, on how GeM has been especially transformative for MSMEs, startups, entrepreneurs, and local suppliers by democratising access to government markets. He emphasised that the platform has aligned public procurement with national priorities such as Make in India and Vocal for Local, while fostering fair competition, inclusivity and improved ease of doing business
