The School of Corporate Law, IICA conducted the inauguration ceremony of the First Six Month Online Certificate Course on Corporate Law at the Indian Society of International Law (ISIL), New Delhi on 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2015. A total of 34 participants from the private sector, individual professionals and students have been enrolled in the Course.

**Dr. Bhaskar Chatterjee**, DG & CEO, IICA, delivered the Inaugural Address. In his speech Dr. Chatterjee appreciated the continued efforts made by the School of Corporate Law towards building capacity in the field of Corporate Law through its various long and short term courses and policy research.
