

Second Annual National Research Workshop on Corporate Governance

The School of Corporate Governance & Public Policy, IICA, conducted the Second Annual National Research Workshop on February 25 & 26, 2015 at New Delhi. The academic workshop was organised to explore the on-going and potential research in the field of corporate governance and related areas.

The Chief Guest for the programme was **Mr. Rajiv Bajaj**, Chief Financial Officer and Company Secretary, Panasonic AVC Networks India Co. In his address to the participants, Mr. Bajaj stressed the need for credible research to set benchmarks in corporate governance.

Around 16 research papers were presented during sessions on *Convergence in Corporate Governance, Governance: Regulation, Practice & Beyond, and Shared value Creation and CSR*. The sessions were chaired by **Professor Surajit Mazumdar** from Centre for Economic Studies and Planning (CESP), JNU, **Professor Jaivir Singh**, Centre for Law and Governance, JNU and **Mr. AB Chakraborty**, Chief Sustainability Officer, Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Development, IICA.

The workshop included a panel discussion on '*Research in Corporate Governance: Nuts & Bolts*', which was chaired by **Professor Subhasis Gangopadhyay** from Shiv Nadar University. The event concluded with distribution of awards to three research papers adjudged the best. The programme was well received by all the participants who acknowledged the role of institutions in creating a dynamic space for corporate governance research in India.
