Requirement:

- Each Field Researchers will be provided a Project Stipend of Rs. 1000 per day.
- Eligibility criteria : Graduate or Post Graduate in Social Work with experience in data collection / survey. Must be proficient in the Local Language.
- The Field Supervisors will be provided a Project Stipend of Rs. 1200 per day.
Eligibility criteria: Masters degree in Social Science with experience in Surveys and Field Studies. Must be proficient in Assamese Language.

The Company will make arrangements for food, accommodation and local travel in the villages.

Survey Methodology:

The Student Social Workers are expected to complete the data collection process within 15 days.

Once selected, we will train the students with respect to data collection process. The research tools such as Questionnaires and Interview Schedule have been prepared by IICA which will be shared with the field researchers during the training session.
