Requirement:

The Field Researchers and Supervisors must be proficient in the Local Language spoken in the Bharuch district of Gujarat.

- Each Field Researchers will be provided a Project Stipend of Rs. 1500 per day.

Eligibility criteria : Graduate or Post Graduate in Social Work with experience in data collection / survey. Must be proficient in Gujarati Language.

- The Field Supervisors will be provided a Project Stipend of Rs. 2000 per day.

Eligibility criteria: Masters in Social Science with experience in Surveys and Field Studies. Must be proficient in Gujarati Language.

The Company will make arrangements for food, accommodation and local travel in the villages.

Survey Methodology :

The total Sample size of the project is : **5000 Household**

The Student Social Workers are expected to complete the data collection process within 15-20 days.

Once selected, we will train the students with respect to data collection process. The research tools such as Questionnaires and Interview Schedule have been prepared by IICA.
