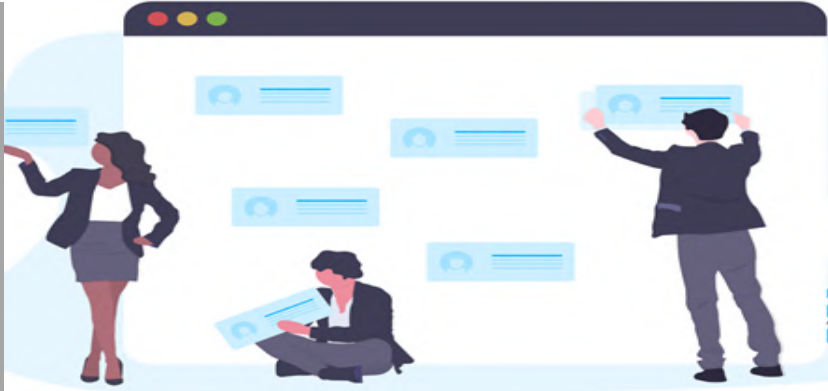
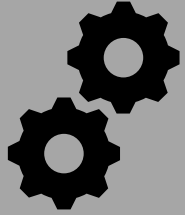

More recently, the centre provided technical support for the revision and updating of the NVGs as National Guidelines on Responsible Business Conduct (NGRBC), with the objective of aligning them with the UNGPs and the Sustainable Development Goals 2030.

The recent research study conducted by the centre has also informed the decision of MCA for revising the Business Responsible Reporting (BRR) to Business Responsibility and Sustainability Reporting (BRSR). The CBHR has also rendered technical assistance to MCA to launch National Action Plan (NAP) on Business and Human Rights, with particular focus on the business responsibility to respect human rights.
