Chaudhary, Insolvency Professional Central Council Members – ICSI (Liquidation Process and Voluntary Liquidation Process) and Ms. Shreya Garg, Vidhi Centre for Legal Policy, New Delhi. (Bankruptcy for non-corporate and individuals). Dr. Vijay Kumar Singh, Head, School of Corporate Law about addressed the participants on Challenges in implementation of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code.
